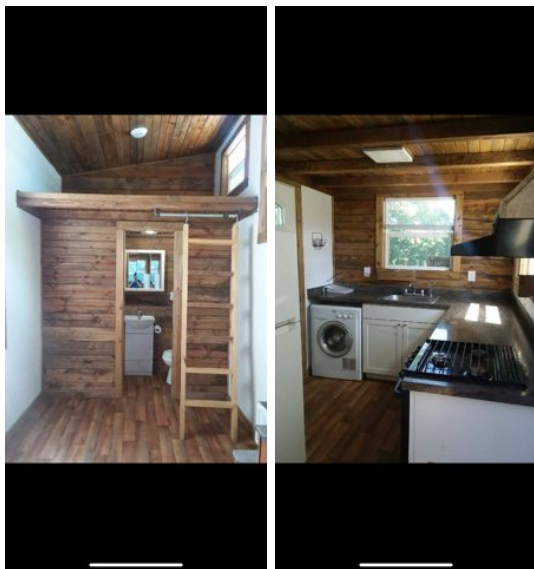


Vega Family: Woodcross
